

Dear Pawsitive Park Supporters,

Pawsitive Park will be a 1.25 acre dog park located on Asylum Street in Norwich. Dogs will be able to run and play off-leash. The area offers views of downtown and the sounds of Indian Leap Falls in the background. The goal for opening the park is May 2005.

Pawsitive Park will improve the quality of life in Eastern Connecticut by providing:

- Alternate recreational opportunities with our "best friends"
- Educational opportunities to promote responsible dog ownership
- Opportunities to foster positive social interactions
- A safe place for dogs to socialize and exercise

Asylum Street is a well-traveled road and the area is flat, open and visible from the road. The area will be fenced with 5' black chain-link fence. There will be a double-gated entrance for safety. The Park will include three separate areas. About 1/4 acre will be reserved for senior and small dogs while an acre will be for larger, more "rambunctious" dogs. A third small area will provide a safe place for small children who accompany their family pet to the park.

Pawsitive Park will have benches, trees and a walking path that will encircle the perimeter of the Asylum Street site. Dogs and their people from all over the area will come to enjoy the park! For those who don't currently share their life with a dog, they are welcome to come and watch the dogs run and play!

While the City has generously donated the site for the project, all fencing and amenities must be paid for with private donations. With the input of City officials, the cost to create the park has been estimated at \$25,000. Fundraising efforts include solicitation of individual and corporate donations, contribution canisters at local businesses and donations for commemorative bricks.

The Commemorative Bricks will be in three different park areas. The entrance pathway will honor businesses while the family area will be paved with bricks remembering a person or naming a family. A very special area for pet memorials will be central to the park. After the Park is open, the Pet Memorial Bricks donation program will be ongoing

The bricks are laser-etched to provide a beautiful, glossy, shiny message. The bricks will last indefinitely. Several local projects have used these bricks, one being the Integrated Day Charter School in Norwich. The bricks are indeed fantastic. The mini-brick, an exact replica of your donated brick, is yours to keep as a memento of your donation!
